

Industry Advisory Panel – Early Career Representative

The Industry Advisory Panel exists to guide the Society's support for the career development of molecular bioscientists working in industrial settings and promotion of academic/industry collaboration.

Members of the panel are required to share their insights from their experience in industry to develop strategies to grow the Society's industry membership and support and ensure industry is represented and engaged across our varied activities (events, training, publications, grants, and more).

Early career representatives must be within 10 years of their most recent postgraduate qualification.

We particularly encourage applications from those working in sectors including manufacturing, industrial biotechnology, agrochemicals/food, and technical roles, all of which are currently underrepresented in the panel.

Requirements for the Industry Advisory Panel Early Career Representative role include:

- To be proactive in supporting links between academia and industry and promoting the widening of membership across specialist sectors, facilitating innovation and collaboration;
- To identify and increase opportunities for the Society to engage with industry;
- To input and advise on Society activities of relevance to industry.
